My name is Yueh Chuang, and my family and I are incredibly grateful to St. Peter's Health Hospice.

In late June 2024, I reached out to St. Peter's Hospice as my mother's health rapidly declined. She was enduring constant pain from serious injuries, while also struggling with advancing dementia. During this already difficult time, our family was also navigating the unexpected loss of my brother. The nurse and social worker not only tended to my mother's medical needs, but also brought moments of comfort and laughter into her days. Their visits—even the small kindnesses, like sharing homemade treats—were gifts of peace in the midst of our sorrow.



I came to rely on the regular check-in calls from the St. Peter's Hospice bereavement and volunteer coordinator. Those conversations provided reassurance and guidance when I needed it most, both before and after my mother's passing. The ongoing support—including grief groups—helped me carry the heavy weight of loss while continuing to care for my family.

Earlier this year, my father-in-law also passed away. Because of my experience with St. Peter's Hospice, my wife and I knew without hesitation that hospice care would provide the same compassion, comfort and dignity for him and our family. We cannot imagine our journey through grief without the extraordinary care of hospice.
